1. There are two registration options:

2. The registration fee is \$8.00 per student. Make checks payable to BBVMTA.

3. Students may participate in these recitals through their senior year in High School.

4. For pianists, no arrangements of Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Contemporary music are allowed.

5. Solo piano music must be memorized.

6. Each student may play at most two pieces. Each movement of a sonata, sonatina, or suite counts as one piece.

7. Each teacher will be allotted 10 minutes. A teacher may submit a list of "stand-by" participants, who will be included if time and circumstances permit.
