1. **The Recital is November 13 at the Richmond Free Library. Recital time is 1:30. If a second recital is needed, it will be at 4:00, and Ed will send an email for your preference.**

**Registration deadline is Tuesday, November 1.**

3. The registration fee is \$8. per student. (Checks should be made payable to BBVMTA.) If you register online, send checks prior to the recital.
4. Students of BBVMTA members may participate through their senior year in high school.
5. For piano pieces, no arrangements of Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Contemporary music are allowed.
6. Solo piano music must be memorized.
7. Each movement of a sonata, sonatina, or suite counts as one piece.
8. Each student may play at most two pieces.
9. Each teacher will be allotted 10 minutes. A teacher may submit a list of "stand-by" participants, who will be included if time permits.

### **10. *BBVMTA Recital Etiquette (please discuss this with your students and their parents):***

1. We request that students sit quietly and respectfully with their parents. We ask that no one leave his/her seat during any student's performance, and that students and their guests remain at the recital until it concludes.
2. Please hold your applause until the student has performed all his/her pieces.
3. We request no flash photography during any performance.
4. FACE MASKS are optional.
